



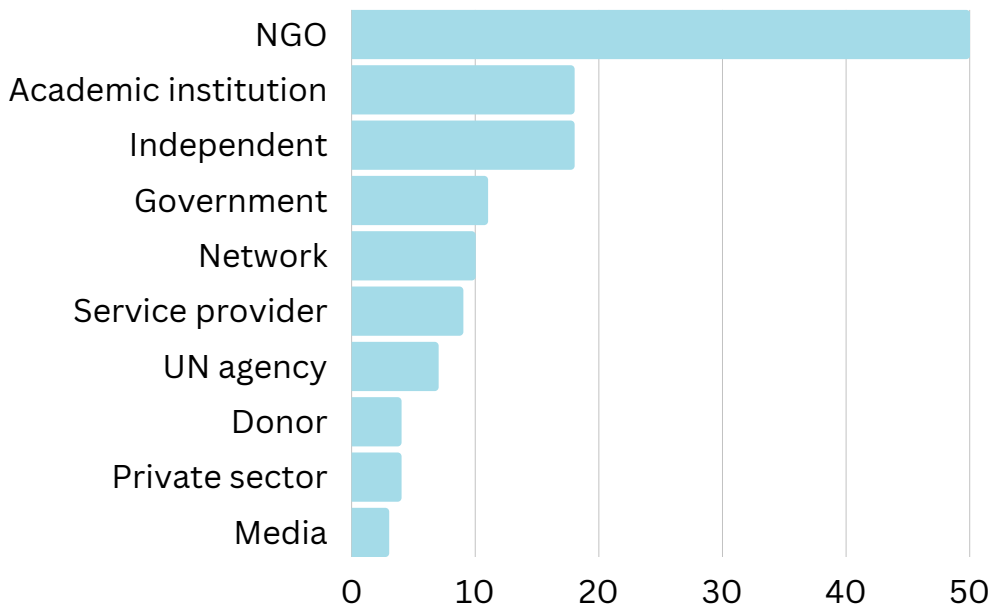
Partner Engagement Survey Results

We asked and you answered! Here are some of the key things we learned.

In early January 2023, ECDAN sent out an online survey to its e-news mailing list to learn more about what we are doing well and what we can improve. We appreciate the time people took to respond and want to demonstrate how we are taking these recommendations forward.

WHO responded?

50% of respondents reported being affiliated with an NGO.

This was followed by academic institution, government, network, and others.

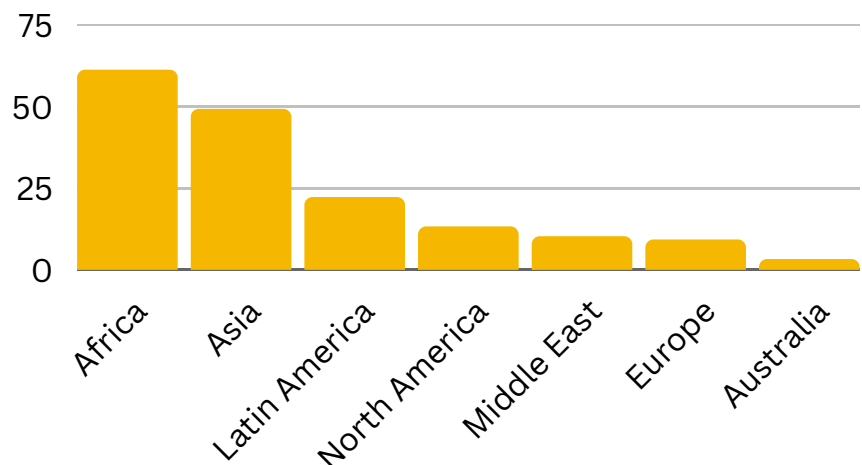


Region of work

■ % of respondents

61% of respondents reported working in Africa.

This was followed by Asia then Latin America as the top regions. Many respondents work across multiple regions.



WHAT did they report?

85% of respondents agreed or strongly agreed that ECDAN adds value to them/their organization.

When asked how frequently they interact with ECDAN, 42% reported 6+ times per year and 38% reported 3-5 times per year.



Perceive ECDAN's value addition

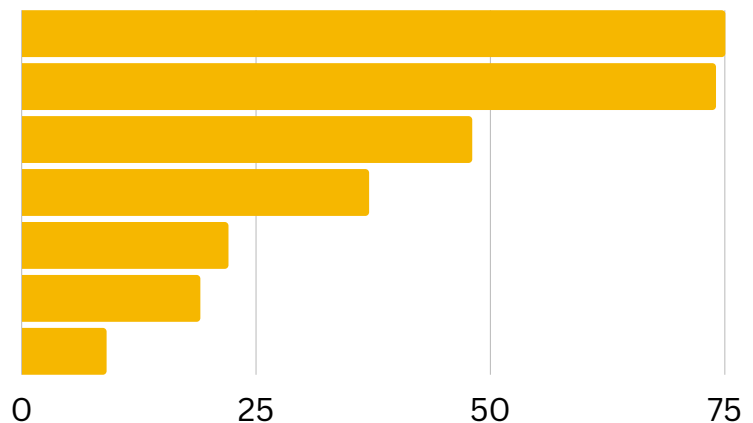
75% of respondents receive and read ECDAN's newsletter and 74% attend webinars.



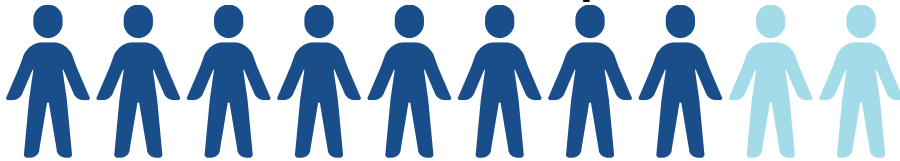

Biggest impact: Increased knowledge or awareness on ECD topics



78% of respondents said interacting with ECDAN had increased knowledge or awareness on ECD topics.

The next top responses were feeling they had contributed to or benefited from knowledge exchange (34%) and getting involved in collaborative ECD initiatives (33%).

72% of respondents said ECDAN could better serve the ECD movement by providing more collaboration opportunities.

Several respondents (15%) recommended that ECDAN expand engagement to smaller, local actors..

HOW will ECDAN use this information?

We have taken note that the community would like ECDAN to diversify participation and offer resources, training, meaningful consultation, and funding to country-level partners. We also heard that having resources translated and interpretation during webinars would make our offerings more inclusive. Finally, we understood that our website and ECD Connect forum need reorganization. All these are part of our 2023 plans and will be carried forward into our next strategic plan.
