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Purpose of the Global ECCE Reports

The **Tashkent Declaration (2022)** mandates that UNESCO publish **biennial global ECCE reports**.

The **first Global Report** was co-published with UNICEF in **2024**, aiming to:

- Strengthen collaboration with key partners
- Support Member States in ECCE policy and system strengthening
- Monitor the implementation of the Tashkent Declaration



The **second Global Report (2026)** will be co-published with **UNICEF and the OECD**, with contributions from diverse partners to accelerate progress toward **SDG Target 4.2**.

The **2026 edition focuses on:**

- **Financing equitable and inclusive access to quality ECCE**
- Innovative solutions to reach young **marginalized children** and **underserved age groups**
- Provides a **solution-oriented approach** for governments, stakeholders, and CSO
- Elevates ECCE in **education/development financing** and **post-SDG** debates



2026 Edition of the Global Report on ECCE: Report Framing

- Aligns with global commitments and creates opportunities to **position ECCE at a higher priority level in a global debate**
- **Provides progress assessment** on the realisation of SDG 4.2 and key regional commitments
- **Offers innovative financing solutions**, particularly for reaching the most marginalized young children and underserved age groups
- **Positions ECCE** within a broader human rights, macro-developmental and educational context

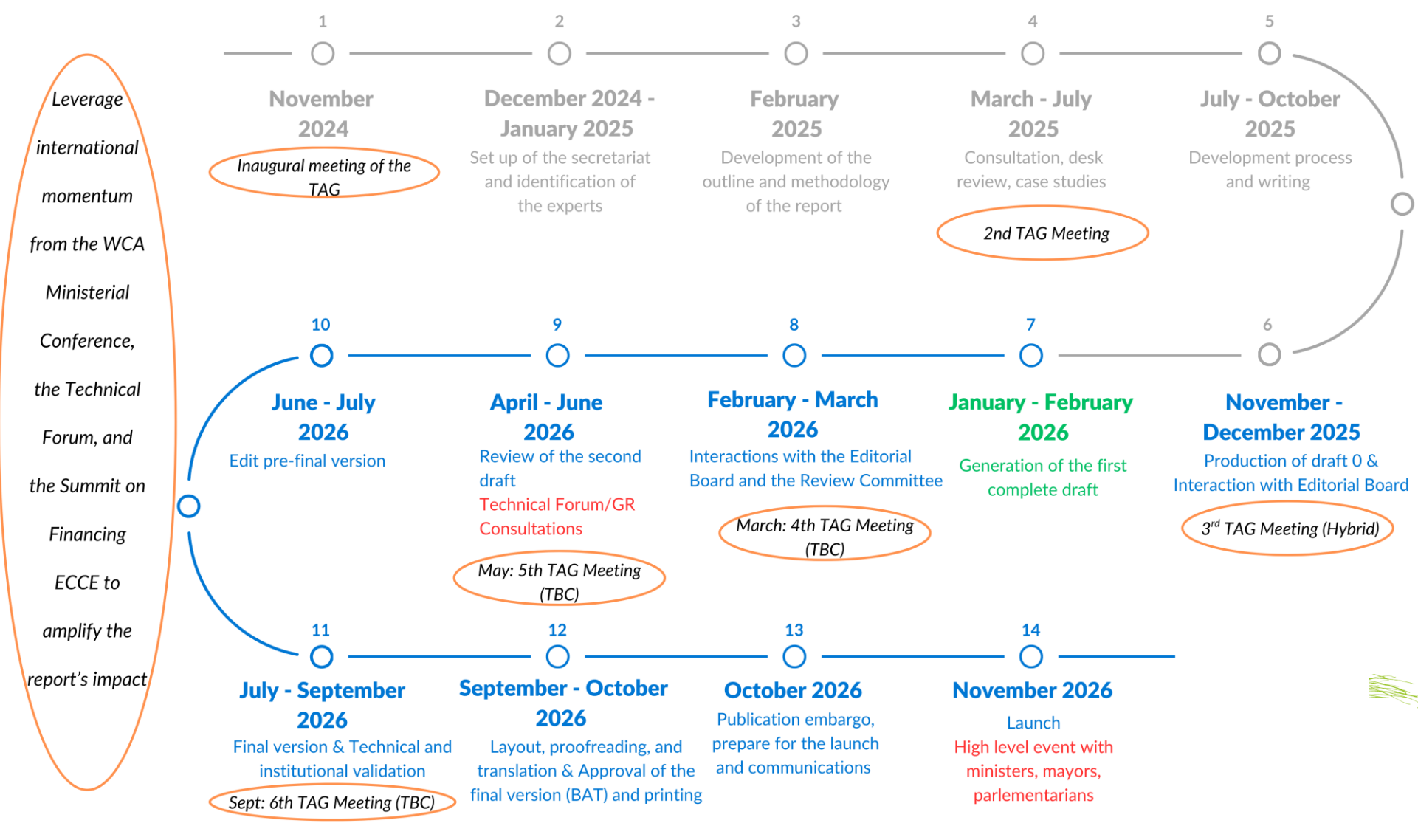

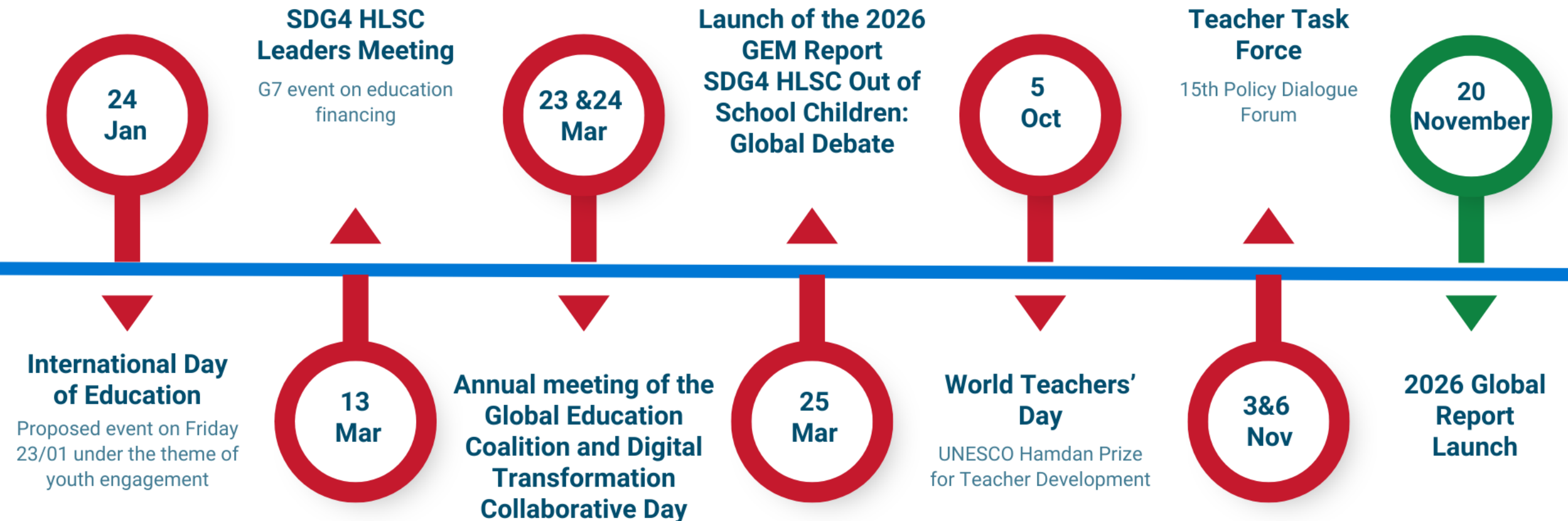

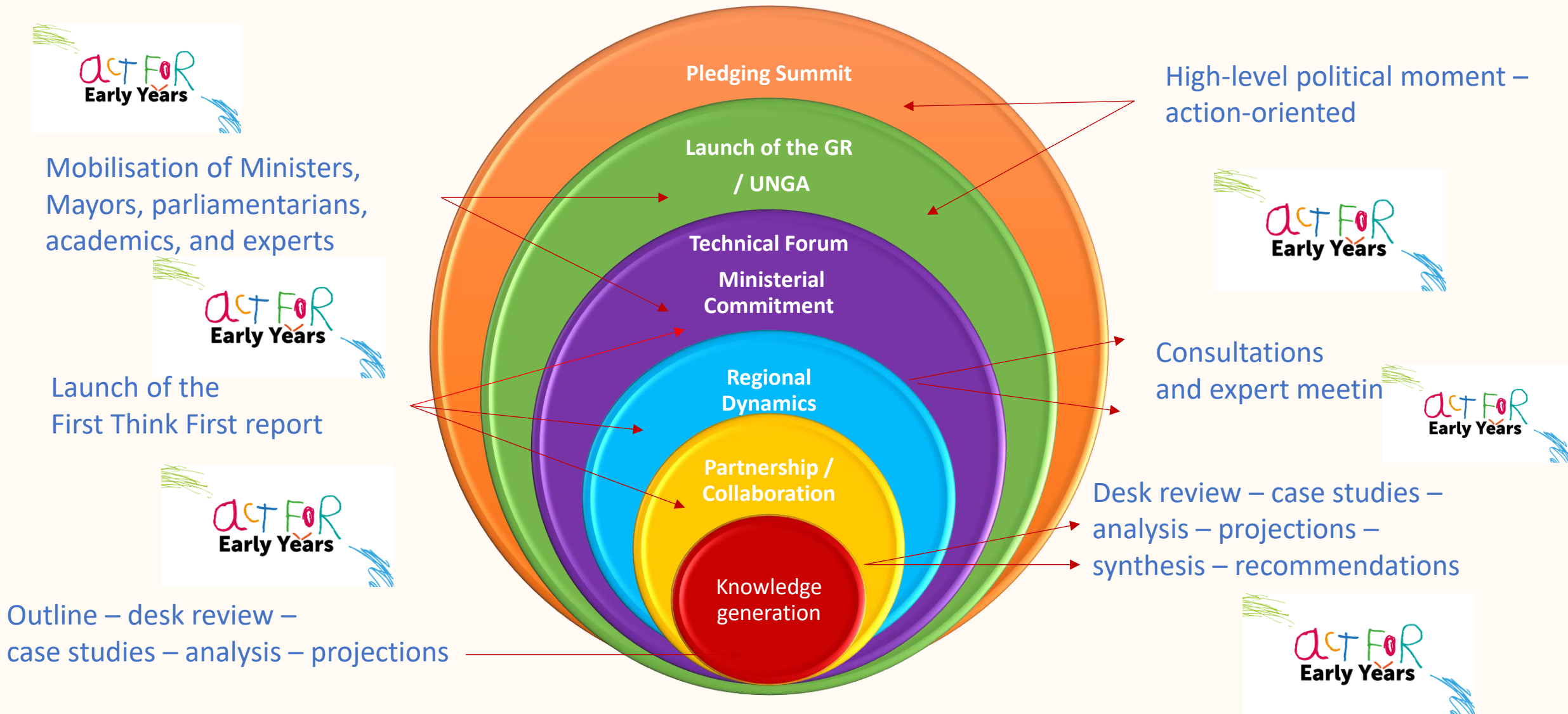




UNESCO key events in 2026
